We the undersigned Chiefs of the Second Christian Party of the Oneida Nation of Indians do hereby acknowledge to have received from the People of the State of New York by the hand of Isaac Deunistou agent for Indian affairs the sum of one thousand dollars \$1,000.00 it being the amount stipulations to be paid to us by a Treaty entered into this first day of February one thousand Eighteen hundred and twenty six between his Excellency the Governor and the Chefs of said Nation February 1st 1826.
