**Detroit Party of Oneidas**

We the undersigned Chiefs of the First Christian Party of the Oneida Indians now denominated the Detroit Party, do hereby acknowledge to have received from the People of the State of New York; by the bonds of Isaac Dermiston Agent for the Indian Affairs the sum of sixty Dollars agreeable to the stipulations of a Treaty made and entered into the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1824 between the Governor of the state of New York of the one part, and Jacob Doxtator, William Hill, and Martines Roctkin of the aforesaid Party of the other part which sum because due to said Indians on the first day of June instant.

Witness our lands the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June Eighteen hundred and Thirty.
