We the First Christian party of the Ononda Nation of Indians do hereby acknowledge to have received from the People of the State of New York, by the hands of Isaac Denniston agent for Indian Affairs, the sum of Thirteen hundred & twenty two dollars & forty three Cents, in full of the several annuities which became due to the first Christian party of the Ononda Nation on the first day of June instant, according to the stipulations mentioned & contained in several certain agreements made with the said first Christian party of the Ononda Nation by the Governor of the said State; the first bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> March 1807. the second bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> February 1809. the third bearing date the 3<sup>rd</sup> March 1810. the fourth bearing date the 7<sup>th</sup> February 1811. the fifth & sixth bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> August 1824.
