Sarah full-blooded Oneida Indian is the name of old Naddy Archiquette mother who lawfully married a man from France by the name of Abesquet General Saffajette's clerk stationed near the Oneida settlement in the state of New York in the year 1700, from where the Archiquette's name originated from who now live in Oneida Wis. - 1902.

In in the 1793 Peter Archiquette's name occurs he signed his name with Oneida's chiefs as witnesses on treaties of the land sales of the six nations in the book of records made in Albany New York - page 194 Samuel Kirkland was there missionary and interpreter of the six nations then.

In year 1824 occurs the name Naddy Abesquet signed his name by mark as witness on page 240 of the book mentioned above - Old Naddy Archiquette Oneida Chief, moved to Green Bay, from Oneida Castle New York, year 1825.
