At a Meeting of the Executive Committee of
the American Board of Commissioners for Foreign
Missions on Tuesday 11th the following
Resolutions were unanimously adopted
Resolved That the U. S. Government be and
they are hereby respectfully requested, if it
be in its power in shape of the necessity
found to withhold any such claims & amount
left to the hands of the Nation, to the extent
the U. S. Govt is the lawful claimant, ^{to pay} the said
claims said claimants apply for said
funds to receive their benefits of the said
claims to themselves, but within not to
be held for the use of the funds
of the Nation as they shall in general
be received. In the absence of the
said U. S. Govt the said claimants
shall receive the same in the
same manner as if the same were
received by the U. S. Govt.
