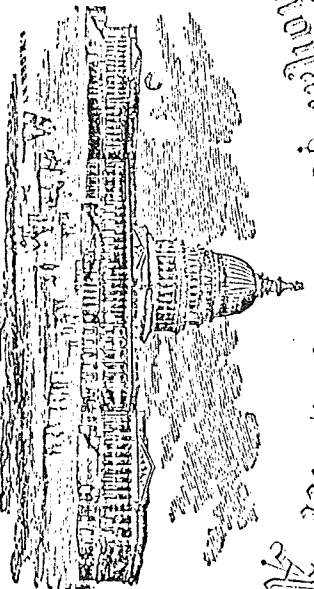

Hon. Commissioner of Indian Affairs

Sir:

I am requested by the delegates of the Oneidas of Wisconsin to ask aid to enable them to come to Washington to attend to the business of their tribe with the government.

You will perhaps remember that the delegation came here last summer or fall to solicit the aid of the Secretary of the Interior to procure for them from Congress a pecuniary allowance in consideration of the insufficiency of their land to afford upon allotment a sufficient amount per capita for making a living, on which occasion the Secretary expressed himself impressed with the propriety of their application. It is as I believe with especial reference to this matter that they now desire to again visit Washington.
