I received from the Indian Office under date of March 24th 1888 - L. 33798 - 1887, Auth. 17325 a letter authorizing me to pay Geo Doxtator \$50, as compensation for relinquishing his claim for improvements on the 80 acre tract of land to be taken for a boarding school farm on the Quicida Reservation, the letter also stated that "a separate communication will be addressed to you giving instructions as to the payment of said sum" which I have not as yet received. I neglected to estimate for the same in the estimate forwarded last week and I inclose a
