I thank for scholarship  
and tell about you on my life time.  
since I was a boy, I remember when  
my mother died, I was only seven  
years, when my mother died, that  
was ten years ago now, after my  
mother died my aunt took me to  
her home and stayed there one  
year then they sent me to school  
it is right close to my home and  
stayed at school about two years  
then I went home, and stayed  
about eight month then my father  
sent me to school again went to  
Phila where they had Indian

School call, Lincoln Inst. stayed  
there two years, and enjoying  
playing all kind of games that  
is when I begin to play base ball  
and practice every day. when we  
get out of school, every Sat after  
noon we would play ball with  
white boys and some time they  
would beat us, but we didn't  
lose every game we play, I  
always play behind the bat, and  
catch for my little team.

Next we was sent to Carlisle  
Indian school, and stayed there  
two years, and go school half  
day. I work in laundry about  
about eleven month, next I was  
ordley for the supt of the school  
name A. H. Pratt, and he was  
pretty good to me. some time

when the visit come to the office  
ask R H Pratt for guard and he  
sent me out to take them around  
about the school, show them where  
is the school house, and where  
their work shop is, after we go  
all around the grounds, I would  
tell them that they have been  
all around now, some time the  
man would paid me one dollar  
for taking all around the school  
grounds.

After I came away from there  
I went to my home, and stayed  
three years and work on my  
grand father farm and help  
him all I could some time he

would give me \$5.00 for helping  
him working in his farm, and  
my grand father he is a soldier  
he is sixty years old now but he  
has a good team of horses and  
have two cows, and lot of chickens.  
Last year ago we raise nine  
hundred bushels of oats and  
wheat, and potatoes about sixty  
bushels.

Last summer, I work on my  
grand father farm again and  
work until first of July then  
I work on a railroad with few  
Indian boys, I did not work  
very long because, I was going  
to school at Hampton Va. I like  
my school very well, before I came  
here to Hampton, I thought, I  
would not see a snow here,

it is very cold, because it is so  
damp that the water is all around  
me.

I have been working in paint  
shop but, I enjoy in working  
at agriculture most of the time  
I think I will close now.
