P E T I T I O N

We, the lawful and qualified Oneida Indians do hereby
Petition your Honorable Bodies:

That the following property known as the Oneida Indian
School, towit: Claim 145, consisting of eighty acres of land,
and Pt. Elaim 146 consisting of 35 acres of land, all school
equipment and all live stock, be kept in tact, and do Petition
that no part or parcel of said property be dispersed or dis-
posed of without the full consent of the Oneida Indians.

WE DO FURTHER PETITION, that the property however dis-
posed of must be still kept as a Reservation for School pur-
poses for Oneida Indians and their decedents, and that no
part or parcel of said Live Stock or Equipment shall be sold
to a private institution or corporation, and that as the Indian
Office has Ordered the closing of said School July 1st, 1919,
we do petition that our prayers be heard by you and that full
consideration be given our claims.
