INDIANS ACTED IN GOOD FAITH, CLAIM

This Will Be Defense of Oneidas Held at Montreal.

MONTREAL —(AP)—While impassive Indians at in the courtroom and listened without sound or movement, counsel for three of their number Thursday claimed for the Iroquois Six Nations all that portion of New York state upon which now stand the cities of Syracuse, Rochester and Buffalo.

The land was sold illegally to early white settlers for a mere song, they said, submitting century-old grants and records of the historic Indian confederacy.

For attempting to raise money among the Iroquois in New York state and Canada, with which to press the Indians' claims against the United States government two Indians were under arraignment in the crowded courtroom.

They were Mr. and Mrs. O. J. Kellogg, of Oneida, Wis., who were arrested by Royal Mounted Police recently at the Caughnawaga reservation 12 miles from here. Accused with them is W. K. Cornelius, brother of Mrs. Kellogg.

After hearing evidence today which indicated the defense will be that the Indians were acting in good faith, Judge Decarie today announced voluntary statements will be received from the defendants March 22.

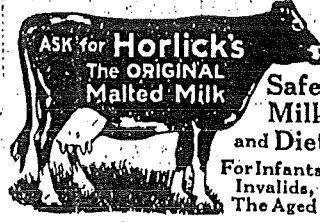
