

Comparison of Position of Project
Coordinator of the Menominee-Oneida
VISTA Project and Comparable Positions

Project Coordinator
Menominee-Oneida VISTA Project

Annual Salary - \$12,000

Requirements include overall design and coordination of the Menominee-Oneida VISTA project including recruitment of local VISTA volunteers, recruitment of local supervisors, training of 22 local and national VISTA's, identification and arrangement of faculty to be involved in VISTA training, identification and arrangement of faculty to serve as resource persons and consultants to the 22 VISTA's. He will be responsible for program logistics and arrangements for the 22 VISTA's including arrangements for housing and training at Green Bay, arrangement for conferences in the target communities of Oneida, Keshena and Neopit, arrangement of follow-up conferences, at least one per month for all 22 VISTA's. He will be responsible for budgetary expenses, budgetary reporting and related matters. Personnel requirements are a B.S. degree (essential in training efforts and in working with faculty) plus several years of direct or related experience in working with disadvantaged, plus the ability to work easily with VISTA's university faculty and community leaders.

COMPARABLE POSITION 1

Academic Conference Coordinator
University of Wisconsin-Green Bay

Annual Salary - \$12,000

Requirements include overall coordination of academic seminars at UWGB working with faculty members and community leaders and others, as well as students, to develop problem oriented conferences and workshops of particular relevance to various colleges of UWGB and communities of Northeast Wisconsin. Will be responsible for program logistics and arrangements, public information regarding seminars, budgetary expenditures, and budgetary justification and reporting. Personnel requirements are a M.S. degree (essential minimum in working with university faculty) plus several years of direct or related experience pertaining to conferences, plus the ability to work with university faculty, community leaders and others.

COMPARABLE POSITION 2

Executive Director
United Fund

Annual Salary - \$

This position involves coordination of fund requests and budgetary expenditures of United Fund (charitable and service) agencies. These are primarily service agencies for individuals and families. It involves working with personnel in the charitable service agencies, other community leaders, university personnel and others to identify needs, problems and opportunities pertaining to individual, faculty and community services. Responsibility includes logistics of budgetary allocation, budgetary expenditures, and budget documentation, plus management of a staff required to facilitate these efforts. Personnel requirements are a M.S. degree plus several years of direct or related experience.

COMPARABLE POSITION 3

Community Organizer
Family Services Division
State Department of Social Services

Annual Salary - \$12,000

Requirements include coordination of community organizations and projects in a seven county area of Northeastern Wisconsin, arrange conferences and workshops for community leaders, conduct training sessions for division staff personnel, and handle administrative liaison details among components of various state-local, educational, social, and community organizations.
Degree level: Masters degree.

COMPARABLE POSITION 4

Title III Project
Director
Shawano School District

Annual Salary - \$13,000

Requirements include directing Federal funded project to develop curriculum for Indian students and train teachers to work with Indian children with different cultural, economic, and social backgrounds. Developing liaison with community organizations and inscussing closer school, parent, student relationships are key responsibilities. Degree level: Masters degree.
