
Dear Mrs. Danforth:

In the minutes of the council meeting of July 3, we note that a discussion was held relative to cutting sufficient trees from the CCC camp ground area to make room for building an outdoor platform and two outbuildings.

This office has no objection to this proposal. If only a few trees are to be cut and the cut material is to be salvaged as fuelwood for use in the council building, no further permit will be needed than this letter. However, if some individual is going to cut the trees and sell the logs, then a timber cutting permit will be needed, and he would be required to pay nominal stumpage on the logs sold.

Mr. Marshall Hall, Field Representative, from this office plans on being in the Oneida area next week, and he should be informed then if a permit should be issued to some individual for cutting and selling this material.
