The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby request continuation of the Tribal Government Development Program Contract Number F50C14300615.

The 1974 scope are as follows: The Contractor shall provide: All personnel, materials, equipment, supplies, facilities and services, except those provided by the U.S. Government, for developing leadership and enterprise essential for eventual self-sufficiency of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

In 1974 the goal of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin will have the Tribal Manager continue to provide the following:

- a. Up-dated and maintain all Tribal records, minutes and correspondence.
- b. Will utilize adequate office procedures for the smooth and efficient operation of the Oneida Tribal Office.
- c. Arrange for various types of training that would be most beneficial for the Oneida Business Committee.
- d. Write proposals to enhance the economic and social structure of the Oneida Tribe, which has a service population of some 3000 Tribal members.

The Oneida Tribe has no funds available for Capital investment, and must rely for the most part on Federal Programs.

A future housing development that will generate income for the Tribal general fund.

The development of the commercial site that is adjacent to the airport, would consist of a motel, conference room and a recreation center. This site would also include a light industrial area.

The amended Wisconsin Industrial Revenue Bond Law appears to open a new approach to Industrial Development. A reliable company can now proceed in a relatively short period time.

Efforts are being made to raise funds to support a total Tribal operation.

- e. A revised draft of the Constitution and By-Laws is ready for consideration by the Tribe. It can then go forward for a Secretarial election.
