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1817 - 1856

Treaty of March 30, 1817. --A treaty of peace and friendship, concluded at St. Louis. [Proclaimed December 26, 1817]. James Monroe, President.

Treaty of August 11, 1827 [with the Chippeway, Menominee and Winnebago]. --Establishment of Indian tribal territories, concluded at the Butte des Morts on Fox River. [Proclaimed February 23, 1829]. John Quincy Adams, President.

Treaty of February 8, 1831. --A treaty of land cessions, concluded at the City of Washington. [Amended February 17, 1831; ratified June 25, 1831; proclaimed July 9, 1832]. Andrew Jackson, President.

Treaty of October 27, 1832. --A treaty of land cessions, concluded at Green Bay. [Proclaimed March 13, 1833]. Andrew Jackson, President.

Treaty of September 3, 1836. --A treaty of land cessions, concluded at Cedar Point, near Green Bay. [Ratified February 10, 1837; proclaimed February 15, 1837]. Andrew Jackson, President.

Treaty of October 18, 1848. --A treaty of cessions, concluded at Lake Pow-aw-hay-kon-nay. [Ratified January 23, 1849].

Treaty of May 12, 1854. --A treaty of cessions, and establishment of the Menominee Reservation, concluded at the Falls of Wolf River; supplementary and amendatory to the Treaty of October 18, 1848. [Ratified August 2, 1854; proclaimed August 2, amended August 22, 1854]. Franklin Pierce, President.

Treaty of February 11, 1856. --A treaty of cessions, concluded at Keshena. [Ratified April 18, 1856; proclaimed April 24, 1856]. Franklin Pierce, President.

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TREATIES BETWEEN THE ONEIDA INDIANS

AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA:

1784-1838

Treaty with the Six Nations [including the Oneida], concluded at Fort Stanwix, October 22, 1784.

Treaty with the Six Nations [including the Oneida], made at Fort Har-
mar, January 9, 1789.

Treaty with the Six Nations [including the Oneida], made at Kon-on-
daigua, New York, November 11, 1794.

A Treaty between the United States and the Oneida, Tuscorora, and

Buffalo Creek, New York, January 15, 1838.
