January 1, 1923

Letter from Laura Cornelius Kellogg asking for special attention  
when the property (Oneida school property) is again put up for re-adv-  
ertisement.

Laura received a letter from Chas E. Burke telling her that she will  
receive special notice of such re-adv-ertisement.

Chas E. Burke also sent a letter to Edgar A. Allen, Supt. Keshena  
School informing E.A. Allen that Mrs Kellogg should receive special  
notice of re-adv-ertisement.

February 7, 1923

Letter from Chief Clerk to Edgar A. Allen in regards to a 9.50 bill  
of the Green Bay Press-Gazette for advertising the sale of the Oneida  
School plant.

February 16 1923

Letter from E.B. Meitt to E.A. Allen advising that inasmuch as Allen  
had paid the bill of the Green Bay Press-Gazette from Indian money, Pro-  
ceeds of labor, Oneida School.

May 3, 1923

Letter from Chas H. Burke to Laura C. Kellogg informing her of the  
deferring of the disposition of the property.

July 6, 1923

Letter from Chas H. Burke to EA. Allen, stating there is no law under  
which either the tribal property or the government tract can be devoted  
to any organization or to the state.

Aug. 6, 1923

Letter from E.A. Allen to Comm. of Ind. Affairs, advising of action  
intended by the Murphy Land Investment Co. of Green Bay.

Oct. 18, 1923

Letter from E.B. Meitt to E.A. Allen advising him to send a copy of  
papers containing the re-adv-ertisement, to Charles S. Lusk, sec. for the  
Bure. of Cath. Ind. Missions, 2021 H Street, N.W. Wash. D.C.

Oct. 22, 1923

Letter from E.A. Allen to the Commissioner of Ind Affairs, stating  
that further advertisement of the Oneida property had not been made.

Oct 30, 1923

Letter from E.B. Meitt to E.A. Allen, telling Allen that there is  
no objection to advertise by posters and circular letters.

Feb. 29, 1924

Letter from Chas H. Burke to Sen. J.W. Harold, regarding the hold  
up of the re-adv-ertisement of the Oneida School Property.

April 10, 1924

Letter from J.R. McCarl, Comptroller General of the U.S. to Chief  
Clerk, disallowing the claim of the Milwaukee Journal, in the sum of \$33.41  
representing publication of advertisement of sale of the Oneida Indian  
school plant, on Jan. 25, Feb. 1, 8, 15, 22, and March 8, 15, 22, 1923, because  
the publication was not authorized.

July 13, 1924

Letter from Secretary Land S. Farnsworth to C.A. Allen, regarding a bill of \$21,744.00 to the Florida National Plant.

July 15, 1924

Letter from C.A. Allen to Com. of Ind. Affairs, regarding the bill on behalf of the Florida National Plant and Farnsworth's bill of the amount of \$21,744.

July 15, 1924

Letter from C.B. Hirsch to C.A. Allen in regard to the message to the Bill. Journal.

July 20, 1924

Letter from Secretary, Bureau of the Budget to C.A. Allen, regarding a form of legislation to be proposed to Congress, in relation to the payment to the Bill. Journal.

December 4, 1924

Letter from C.A. Allen to the Commissioners of Indian Affairs, Wash. D.C., regarding the special legislation to pay the \$21,744 to the Bill. Journal.

This letter also mentions about the \$21,744 used in the Green Bay Forest Service and \$21,600 in the Appalachee Park Commission. The \$1,600 was received in the Com. of Ind. Affairs office on June 12, 1923.

December 12, 1924

Letter from C.A. Allen to the Commissioners of Indian Affairs, Wash. D.C., of the receipt of a letter from the Appalachee Park Commission, saying that they had been paid out of the subject amount on in their paper, about the Florida National Plant in the year 1923.

February 9, 1925

Letter from C.B. Hirsch to C.A. Allen, regarding the payment of \$2,500 on March 5, 1923 to the Green Bay Forest Service.

Jan. 10, 1925

Letter from the Chief Clerk, New. and Budget Office to Secretary, Bur. of the Budget, regarding the bill for the subject of the Bill. Journal. Formatted in accordance with paragraph 3b of Budget Circular 49 and Departmental Orders of Jan. 8, 1925, and Feb. 12, 1924.

Feb. 3, 1925

Letter from Herbert Work to Secretary, Bur. of the Budget, regarding the legislation to allow a claim in favor of the Florida National Plant.
