Lois J. (Moore) Powless served five years on the Oneida Tribe Business Committee after being elected in 1982. During her term, she was appointed to the United Nations Council by former Wisconsin Governor Tony Earl. She also served on the New York Land Claims Committee.

Powless, 61, has lived most of her life in the Seymour and Oneida area. She and her husband, John, have been married for 42 years. They have six children. She was born Nov. 20, 1928, ~~to Simon and Irene (Metoxen) Moore~~ at her childhood home in Oneida ^{IN} to ^{Simon} and Irene (Metoxen) Moore. Her mother, Irene Moore, also served on the Tribal Council and was the first woman ~~elect~~ elected chairman in 1963.

Powless attended grade school at the Oneida State Graded School at Chicago Corners in Oneida. She attended ~~East Green Bay High School~~ Green Bay East High School and Haskel Institute in Lawrence, Kansas. She also took marketing classes at the Fox Valley Technical College in Appleton and the Northeast ~~Technical~~ Wisconsin Technical College in Green Bay. As a member of the Oneida United Methodist Church, Powless served as chairman of the Methodist Women's Society from 1986 to 1989. Before elected to the Business Committee, Powless worked as a social worker for the Oneida Tribe Income Maintenance Program. Currently, she manages the Iroquois Gift Shop at the Radisson Inn ~~on the Oneida reservation~~, and the Smoke Shop at Irene Moore Activity Center, both are located on the Oneida reservation.

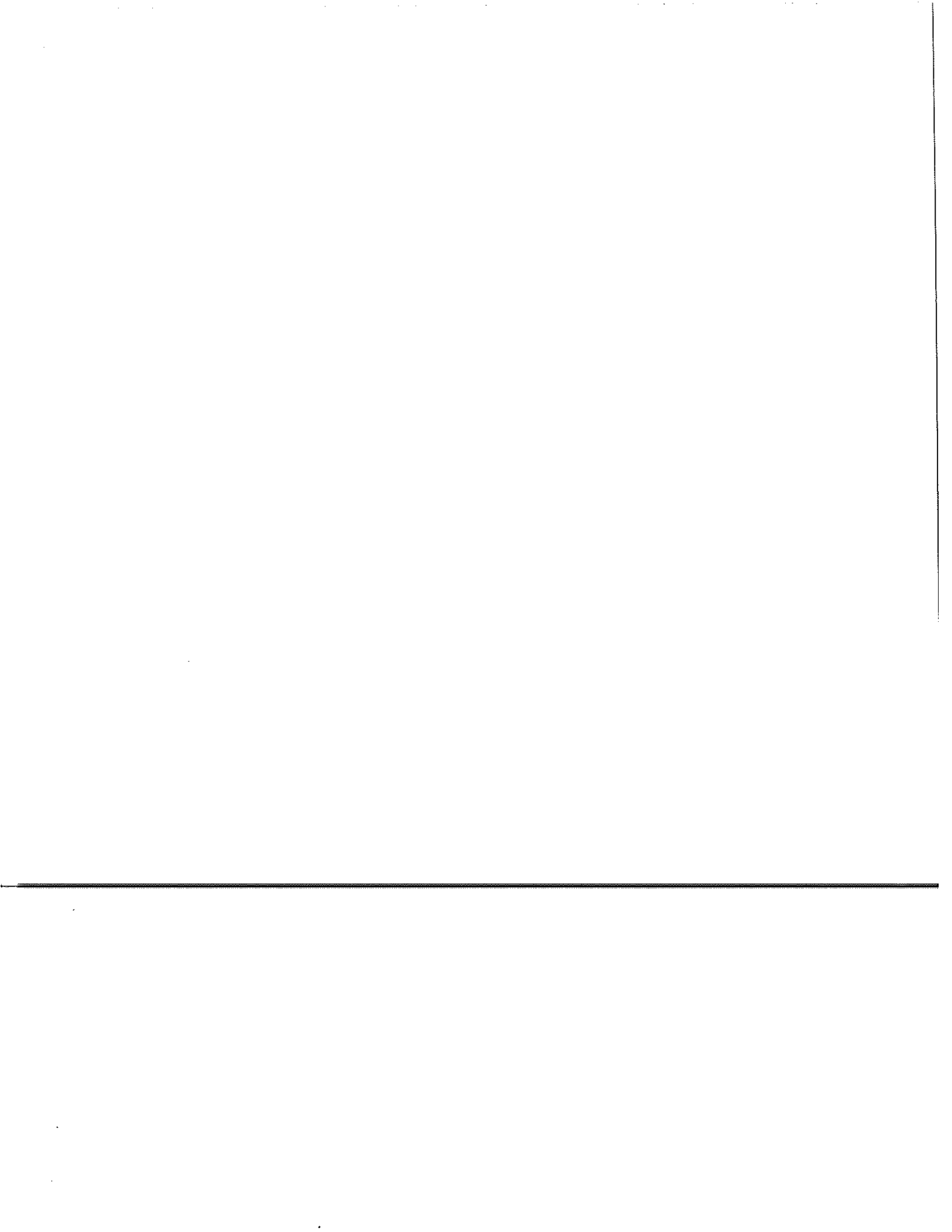
