I hope I do not intrude, —
Our agent does not desire
advice of our old chiefs, or
the sense of the young business
of our Nation; — which has

I have desired to see, and tell
you all. — Our agent seemed
to be afraid to let you
know so. —

May we hope that you
will fully investigate, and have
no personal. —
